



In the case your child feels unwell

If your child becomes unwell over night or over a weekend with a **new, continuous cough or a high temperature, or has a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)**, they must stay at home and get tested. This includes siblings.

If the test is positive your child will need to isolate for 7 days.
The rest of your house hold will need to isolate for 14 days

If the test is negative your child can return to school as soon as they're feeling better.

The school will need to see evidence of this before your child or their sibling return.

If someone else in the family develops symptoms while they are isolating they must get tested

If the test is negative – the person and the rest of the household will need to continue with the original 14 day isolation.

If the test is positive – the person will need to isolate for 7 days from the day the first got symptoms.

If any member of your household tests positive for Coronavirus please inform the school and keep your child(ren) at home for 14 days.
