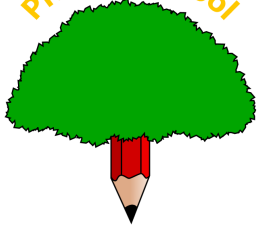

Dear Candidate

Thank you very much for your interest in the post of Relief School Meals Supervisory Assistant.

Some information about the school

We are a good school with approximately 406 children on roll plus a 100 place nursery.

Location - within the London Borough of Ealing

We are situated at the Greenford end of Southall, to the west of Ealing. We are only 5 minutes drive from the main A40 (Western Avenue). We are served by bus routes 120, 105, 207 and Northolt Tube Station (Central Line) is 2 miles away. Southall main line station is 1½ miles away with a 13 minute service direct from Paddington.

Description of Catchment Area and the Community served by the school

Many of our children live in owner occupied properties within the vicinity of the school. Some children live in social housing. Our school backs onto King George's Field which is used by local residents for recreation.

We serve a socially and culturally diverse community whose family ties are predominately in the Indian sub-continent.

The Building and Grounds

The School was built in 1976 and all teaching areas are on the ground floor. We have a purpose built nursery which shares its grounds with our reception classes.

We have an ICT suite which houses 30 networked computers and the pcs in every classroom are networked. .

All classrooms have laptops and interactive whiteboards for teacher use.

The school is well resourced in all curriculum areas.

Organisation

The 100 place purpose-built nursery unit caters for two groups of 50 children in separate morning and afternoon sessions.

Our KS1 and KS2 classes are organised with two classes per year group with a bulge year in Reception from September 2014. Setting for Maths and English takes place in Yr 5 and Yr 6.

Management Organisation

From their second year of teaching, every teacher becomes a **Subject or Aspect leader**, managing development and standards in this area.

School Teams are organised as following, with a **leader** for each.

- Early Years Team (Nursery and Reception)
- Key Stage 1 Team (Year 1 and Year 2)
- Lower Key Stage 2 (Year 3 and Year 4)
- Upper Key Stage 2 (Year 5 and Year 6)

The **School Management Team** consists of the Head Teacher, two Deputy Heads, School Business Manager plus Team Leaders.

Approaches to Teaching

All staff work together with a common sense of purpose.

Children experience success through high quality teaching with well- organised lessons using a range of teaching styles and methods with an emphasis on achievement. Systematic planning and monitoring of the curriculum further support the teaching and learning in the school.

The School has a supportive Governing Body. Our parents are very supportive of the staff and work with them to help their children do well.

The closing date for applications is Friday 27th November 2020.
